- 9:45 AM Parade arrives at site . Check in vets and vehicles
- 10:15 AM Color Guard presents colors, pledge , prayer, Marine 21 gun salute, taps
- 10:25 AM Guard holds up the 80 foot flag, anthem, WW11 flyover
- 10:45 AM Ceremony begins. Vets will be introduced to the crowd
- 12:00 PM Lunch and live music
- 1:00 PM Jeep rides
- 2:00 PM Trophies awarded and prize drawings
- 11:30 AM to 4:00 PM :
Military vehicle rides, shooting range (6 machine guns)
- 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM :
Military living history, Texas Wall, military swap meet, classic car show

Parade Instructions – Saturday, September 14th

- Vehicles and helicopters arrive at Steward Funeral Home by 8:30 am
- Motorcycles set up on the south parking lot
- Large military vehicles set up on the highway
- Small military vehicles set up on the north parking lot in 2 rows close to the home
- Classic cars and trucks set up in 2 rows on the north side of the parking lot
- Any vans or company trucks set up on the highway
- At 9:05 motorcycles pull out first
- Military vehicles pull out second with the larger ones at the rear (no vans)
- Swat vehicles and Fire Department vehicles next
- Auto zone truck behind the fire department trucks
- Patriot Electric vehicles, Pratt Homes vans, classic cars and truck follow
- Huey and CH 46 will fly cover
- Speed will be 33 mph
- Pull in Bullard between the 2 flags set up by our sign off the highway
- Military vehicles unload the vets and park in military section
- Classic cars and trucks park in the car show section
